Player and Parent Code of Conduct (2023-24)

At CVHSS, we are looking for homeschool athletes and families who are committed to Christ and biblical principles of behavior. We desire for our athletes to serve as positive examples in the community and as role models for younger students who observe their behavior. The opportunity to be involved in a CVHAA sports program is a privilege, and athletes as well as their families are expected to behave in an exemplary manner. Participating students and parents must abide by the following code of conduct.

Code of Conduct:

- I will treat my teammates and all others with respect at all times.
- I will not lie, cheat, steal or engage in any other dishonest conduct.
- I will conduct myself with the utmost Sportsmanship at all times.
- I will not use profanity, obscene gestures, or offensive remarks to others.
- I will not use alcohol, tobacco, or illegal drugs at any team event including illegal strength enhancing drugs.
- I will listen to and respond positively to the instruction of the coaches.
- I will be on time for practices and games unless I notify the coach.
- I will have a good attitude in victory as well as defeat.
- I will not argue with the calls by referees or other officials.
- I will respect the facilities in which I am playing by keeping them clean and abiding by all posted rules

The CVHAA Patriots baseball team is a competitive high school and middle school program. This means that coaches will be fielding what they believe to be the best combination of players possible in order to develop players and win games. Equal playing time is not guaranteed at this level, or any higher level of competitive baseball.

Players who are not satisfied with playing time, fielding position, batting order, etc., should ask a coach directly what they can do in order to achieve their personal goals. Parents are encouraged to cheer their sons on and support the team, but should not, under any circumstances, petition coaches for playing time, fielding positions, or other special consideration.
